Safety Warnings

1. Downloading the software from the Codex website

Codex software is available from www.codex.online/software

To access this page of the website you must first register for an account.

The VRAW Recorder software will download as a .zip file. Unzip this file using an application on your computer.

2. Installation

1. Ensure the camera is running and check MENU->SYSTEM SETTINGS->INFORMATION->VERSION. If the VRAW version listed is lower than 03850 then the update can be performed. (The update process will not attempt to re-install or downgrade if the same or higher version is already loaded).
2. Start with the VariCam 35 powered down and attached the VRAW Recorder.
3. Connect power to the VRAW Recorder to power the system.
4. From the unzipped file, copy the folder called Private to an SD card.
5. Follow the instructions to install the firmware update at: http://www.pana.panasonic.co.jp/pro-av/support/content/download/EN/ep2main/soft/varicam/varicam_verup_iabb_e.pdf
6. This procedure will update the VRAW Recorder firmware only. The VariCam 35 firmware will not be changed.
